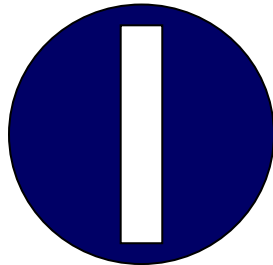

FORMAT: Fleet Racing utilizing HMS 2007 as modified by the Sailing Instructions.

RULES: The regatta will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing for 2005-2008 (RRS) as changed by RRS Appendix E, the Championship Regulations of ISAF RSD, this Notice of Race (NoR), the Sailing Instructions (SI), the International One Metre Class, and The Equipment Rules of Sailing. The Sailing instructions shall prevail in case of conflict with this Notice of Race.

ELIGIBILITY: The Competition is open to all IOM class boats. All entrants must be current members of AMYA or their National Authority and have a valid IOM measurement certificate.

REGISTRATION and EVENT MEASUREMENT: Boats with a valid measurement certificate shall be presented for registration on Friday, May 2, 2008 between the hours of Noon and 6PM at the sailing site for event measurement. However, the race committee may extend the time for registration and event measurement if there is a valid reason to do so. No boat shall be eligible for racing until it has been registered and measured for the event.

WEIGHT SPOT CHECKS: At the discretion of the Race Director, spot checks of sailing weights of randomly selected boats may be conducted during the event. In addition, the top 5 finishing boats in each of the racing days will be weighed. Boats failing to meet minimum IOM class weight will be promptly disqualified without right to appeal.

SCORING and RACING SYSTEM: Scoring will be carried out in accordance with HMS 2007 as modified by the SI's.

PRE-REGISTRATION and FEES: Please this is a must, in order to assure no Radio Channel conflict early on, this really help speeds things up on race days. Also allows us to have adequate amount of food and drinks. Entries are to be made using the official entry form below and forwarded to:

Entry fee is \$45 per boat and includes lunch and beverages. Fees are payable to Detroit Model Yacht Club (DMYC)

FREQUENCIES: Permitted frequency bands are FCC-approved surface bands. Transmitters on 75 MHz must be narrow band certified. Radio frequencies will be allocated on a "first come first served" basis. NO CONFLICTS will be allowed. Each competitor is required to have a minimum of three (3) additional frequencies available. 2.4 Ghz radios are permitted and are exempt from rule E1.5 in the RRS.

FOOD SERVICE: Pizza / Party Sub / Soda and Water.

AWARDS: Prizes will be awarded to the first three positions in the final results.

Delia Park:

Delia Park is located in Sterling Heights Michigan. The entrance to the park is north of 18 Mile Road east of Dequindre (De-Quin-Der). DMYC utilizes the North and East shore of the North Pond. The park is located approximately 5 miles from the Troy Hilton below.

Directions from the Hotel

Turn right on Crooks Road proceed to first turnaround to make a Michigan left and then head south on Crooks Road. Proceed one half mile to Long Lake. Cross Long Lake and make another Michigan left then head north to Long Lake, make a right and head East on Long Lake. Cross Livernois, Rochester Road, John R, then Dequindre (each one mile apart). Long Lake turns into 18 Mile Road once you cross Dequindre. The entrance to the park will be another half mile on the left. Enter park and follow road around to the north side of the pond on the left. Watch your speed in the park.



Troy Northfield Hilton:

The Troy Northfield Hilton is approximately 38 miles or 45 minutes from Detroit Metro Airport (DTW). It is also 45 miles or 50 minutes from Flint Bishop Airport (FNT). **You may want to check air fares to Flint Bishop as well as Detroit Metro. FNT is a regional airport and very easy to get in and out of. Depending on where you are coming from the fare also may be less to FNT than DTW.**

Directions from DTW (Detroit Metro Airport) to the Hotel

- Start going toward the AIRPORT EXIT on **WILLIAM G ROGELL DR** - go **0.2** mi
- Make a U-Turn at BURTON DR onto **WILLIAM G ROGELL DR** toward **RENTAL CAR RETURN** - go **0.3** miles
- Continue on **MERRIMAN RD** - go **0.2**
- Take ramp onto **I-94 E** toward **DETROIT** - go **17.8** mi
- Take exit #216A/**FLINT/TOLEDO** onto **I-75 N** toward **FLINT** - go **18.9** mi
- Take exit #72/**CROOKS RD** - go **0.8** mi
- Turn Right on **CROOKS RD** - go **0.1** mi
- Arrive at 5500 **CROOKS RD**, **TROY**, on the Right

Directions from FNT (Flint Bishop Airport) to the Hotel

- Start going toward the AIRPORT EXIT - go **0.2** mi
- Turn Right on W **BRISTOL RD(M-121)** - go **0.4** mi
- Bear Right to take ramp onto **I-75 S** toward **ANN ARBOR/DETROIT/US-23 S** - go **43.7** mi
- Take exit #72/**CROOKS RD** - go **0.5** mi
- Turn Right on **CROOKS RD** - go **0.1** mi
- Arrive at 5500 **CROOKS RD**, **TROY**, on the Right
