Notice of Race

FORMAT: Three days each of fleet racing, for the National Championship, of Soling 1M, US1M and EC12 Classes.

RACE COURSE: Two (2) times around a Windward-Leeward course with the start and finish to windward, will be favored. An offset mark may be positioned within four (4) boat-lengths from the weather mark. If possible a leeward gate will be set. Alternate courses will be set as dictated by wind and weather conditions.

SCHEDULE OF EVENTS:

Soling Nationals:

Thursday, September 25 - check-in and practice (afternoon)
Friday, September 26 - Racing
Saturday, September 27 - Racing
Sunday, September 28 - Racing – 2:00pm quit

US1M Nationals:

Sunday, September 28 - check-in and practice (afternoon)
Monday, September 29 - Racing
Tuesday, September 30 - Racing
Wednesday, October 1 - Racing – 2:00pm quit

EC12 Nationals:

Wednesday, October 1 - check-in and practice (afternoon)
Thursday, October 2 - Racing
Friday, October 3 - Racing
Saturday, October 4 - Racing – 2:00pm quit

Lunches provided.

Lunch starting at 11:30 depending on progress of racing (it is recommended that you not stop the heat racing for lunch when multiple heats are running. Those not racing will have at time to sit and eat.)

Note: At the Race Director's discretion, there may be a break after 3 completed races.

All awards dinners at Mystic Golf Course (on site) following the end of each National Regatta.

RULES: The regatta will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing for 2005-2008 (RRS) as changed by RRS Appendix E, the Championship Regulations of ISAF RSD, this Notice of Race (**NOR**), the Sailing Instructions (SI), the Soling 1M - US1M - EC12 Classes and The Equipment Rules of Sailing. The Sailing instructions shall prevail in case of conflict with this Notice of Race.

ELIGIBILITY: The Competition is open to all Soling 1M, US1M and EC12 class boats. All entrants must be current members of AMYA or their National Authority and have a valid class measurement certificate.

REGISTRATION and EVENT MEASUREMENT: AMYA or CRYA registered boats should be presented to the measurement committee for measurement. Times for check-in are noted above. However, the race committee may extend the time for registration and event measurement if there is a valid reason to do so. No boat shall be eligible for racing until it has been registered for the event.

WEIGHT SPOT CHECKS: At the discretion of the Race Director, spot checks of sailing weights of randomly selected boats may be conducted during the event. In addition, the top 5 finishing boats in each of the racing days will be weighed. Boats failing to meet minimum class weight will be promptly disqualified without right to appeal.

SCORING and RACING SYSTEM: Scoring will be carried out in accordance with HMS 2007 as modified by the SI's. Low point scoring method will be used. A nine (9)-race minimum constitutes a regatta.

PRE-REGISTRATION and FEES: Please this is a must, in order to assure no Radio Channel conflict early on, this really help speeds things up on race days. Early registration allows us to plan for adequate amounts of food and drinks. Entries are to be made using the official entry form below and forwarded to:

We will begin accepting entries postmarked no earlier than 9AM Saturday June 14, 2008.

FREQUENCIES: Permitted frequency bands are FCC-approved surface bands. Transmitters on 75 MHz must be narrow band certified. Radio frequencies will be allocated on a "first come first served" basis. NO CONFLICTS will be allowed. Each competitor is required to have a minimum of three (3) additional frequencies available. 2.4 GHz "Spektrum" radios are permitted and are exempt from rule E1.5 in the RRS.

FOOD SERVICE: As noted.

AWARDS: Prizes will be awarded to the first five (5) positions in the final results.
